Subject: ISFSI Location Information

Dear Mr. Thrower –

At the September 23 meeting of the Blue Ribbon Commission's Transportation and Storage Subcommittee, NEI's participant, Christopher Earls, was asked to provide the Subcommittee with an indication of the location of Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installations (ISFSIs) at nuclear power plants based on whether the ISFSI was located within a power plant protected area. Below is the list we have developed.

As pointed out by Mr. Earls in his testimony, those ISFSIs not inside a plant's protected area (which is a term-of-art in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regulations) are in their own highly secured areas that meet all security requirements that apply.

Provided below is a summary of information collected by NEI regarding the number and location of ISFSIs currently being used and under planned construction at commercial power reactor and decommissioned sites in the U.S.

- 31 ISFSIs located inside a protected area (power reactor sites)
- 16 ISFSIs located in separate secure areas (power reactor sites)
- 10 ISFSIs at decommissioned sites in secure areas
- 8 ISFSIs currently underway/in construction inside a power reactor protected area
- 5 ISFSIs currently underway/in construction in separate secure areas
